

Nintendo NES NYC Test Market System – Serial #71,680 – Not deluxe set!

- NES deck serial #71680
- 2 controllers
- 1 zapper
- 1 Power Supply
- 1 RF switch
- 75/300 ohm converter
- AV cable, not sure if it originally came with this probably not original
- I believe all paper work:
 - Warranty card; bottom half missing as it was submitted.
 - ROB poster large with game pictures
 - ROB poster small (Three), one with system and one with each cart.
 - Nintendo quality seal insert
 - Instruction manual
 - Filter for Rob, still sealed
 - Caution information sheets on top of Gyros.
- Rob and all parts working
 - ROB with batter cover – works
 - Gyro spinner with batter cover – works
 - 2 x Gyros with Caution sheet attached (listed under paperwork also)
 - Gyro holder
 - Gyro Tray
 - Gyro Hands
- Cartridges
 - Black box Duck Hunt
 - Box – Duck Hunt
 - Duck Hunt cart, with Famicom converter inside
 - Cart sleeve with Nintendo printed on sleeve
 - Styrofoam piece
 - Instructions - Duck Hunt
 - ROB poster small (listed under paperwork as well).

- Box
 - Shows normal wear and tear, has handle attached and undamaged. Box has all tabs, etc.
 - Has both Styrofoam pieces, may have some minor damage dents etc.

New York City Test Market NES system.

I'm the original owner. This is serial # 71,680 of the 100,000 released to test market the NES.

As far as I can recall the only things missing are:

- Plastic bags and twist ties
- Bottom of the warranty card as I mailed it in.
- Not sure if the system came with VA cables, if they didn't I don't think the ones in the box are original.

I tested everything when I took the pictures and video and everything functioned.

How to tell a test market system from a deluxe set:

- Test Market set doesn't say Deluxe set on the front of the box
- Test Market has smaller picture on the front of the box
- Test Market has different wording on the front of the box
- Test Market NES deck serial # \leq 100,000
- Test Market NES deck has ® mark on the cartridge door, after Nintendo, and no ™ after the words entertainment system.
- I'm sure there are other differences
